Temporary Transit Location for ex-Ashraf residents in Camp Liberty

General

Based on the Technical Assessment of Sector 1 on WED 18 January, UNHCR can

- 1) Complete further assessments if the GoI permits.
- 2) Advise and recommend regarding the camp setup, taking the Shelter and Camp Standards for Refugees in Emergencies into account;

The Ashraf caseload may have other and additional demands and requirements.

Advise and recommend in particular on

- Superstructures such as accommodation prefabs, office structures, sanitary units, etc.
- Site planning figures in terms of
 - Land
 - Shelter space
 - Fire break space
 - Roads and walkways
 - Open space and public facilities
 - Environmental sanitation
 - Water
 - Tap stands
 - Warehouse space

It is essential that the GoI permits Ashraf Contractors to enter the TTL 3-5 days prior to relocation of the caseload

From the technical point of view, UNHCR cannot

- 3) Certify and/or verify that the above location meets Humanitarian Standards according to the many existing standard books, i.e. UNHCR Handbook, SPHERE, WHO and others, bearing in mind that these are thought for Refugees in Emergencies.
- 4) UNHCR cannot certify and/or verify the functionality of infrastructures and/or utilities that are buried.
- 5) UNHCR cannot certify and/or verify the functionality of infrastructures, such as
 - Generator sets
 - Water pumps
 - Water supply
 - Water tanks
 - Waste water disposal (pipes, tanks and pumps)
 - Electrical / IT supply and distribution etc.
